Some of our Maths homework tasks will be set online via MathsWatch or MyMaths.

Year 7 are set two new MyMaths homework tasks every week.

Students will be given login details for one or both of these in lesson time. MathsWatch also allows students to watch videos and set tasks for themselves which may be helpful for extra practice or at home revision.

Maintain Progress– Catch up on missed work

If a pupil misses a lesson they have to copy up. They should attempt to do this as soon as possible. Maths is a subject that builds on previous knowledge and skills, if you don't copy up then you may be lost or confused in the next lesson.

Teachers will set homework based on the content the class has been taught, so if you have missed a few lessons it could appear that homework has been set based on a topic that you haven't studied. It is your responsibility to copy up so that you are able to complete all homework set to the best of your ability.

When you miss lessons this could affect your progress and understanding. It is important to attend all lessons to ensure you have the opportunity to improve your maths skills.

Intermediate Maths Challenge 2026

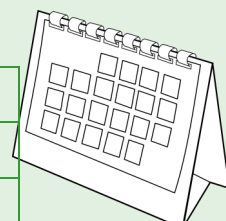
