## **RE: YEAR 11 LEARNING PLANS**

Please find attached learning plans for each subject for your child. The purpose of this document is to provide information and guidance for families in terms of the learning that will take place within school over the next four weeks (this will become half termly) and the learning activities that should be completed to complement the work undertaken in school for each subject. Please note that this plan is flexible and may change for various reasons, e.g. absence, pace of learning etc.

The plan has been organised to show the content that will be covered and skills that will be developed, the key assessment tasks that will be set and the activities that should be completed at home to support learning.

Each subject that your child studies will have a 'TEAM' set up. In this TEAM staff will upload class materials, which the pupils can access, set assignments and completed work can be submitted electronically. All pupils have a username address which allows them to access Teams.

The address is their school [username@bryntirioncs.bridgend.sch.uk](mailto:username@bryntirioncs.bridgend.sch.uk) and the password will be the same as the one they use to log into the computer at school. All pupils will have had lessons on how to access their TEAMS and how to use Office 365. If pupils are away from school for a prolonged period TEAMS is where their remote learning will take place.

## **TEAMS**

Teams are online collaborative working environments for teachers and learners. Staff can post material, information and assignments in the Team for pupils to view and complete.

The easiest way to access Teams is for the pupils' to download the TEAMS app onto their device. This can be achieved by firstly accessing the school website and clicking the link for RMunify in the top left corner. You will be asked to log in (as above), then open One Drive and launch the Teams app. You can then download.

Instructions on how to access the different online learning platforms is available on the school website, along with user guides for using Teams effectively. They are found in the useful links for pupils' area of the website.
